Sub :—Welfare of ex-servicemen—Extension of re-settlement benefits—Allotment of Jai Jawan Stalls, Bunks etc.,—Reg.

Defence Services Personnel retire on completion of their term of service in the Defence Forces. Most of them retire in their forties and have to take up another employment to support their family. The re-settlement of ex-servicemen is a national responsibility. Since all of them cannot be absorbed into Civil Service, they are to be resettled by providing self-employment opportunities. The High Level Committee appointed by the Government of India to probe into the problems of ex-servicemen has stressed the need for providing maximum re-employment opportunities to them. If allotment of Jai Jawan Stalls and Bunks etc., are made to ex-servicemen from a reserved quota instead of the present system of their allotment on priority basis it will go a long way in providing opportunities to ex-servicemen for their re-settlement. To achieve this aim at least 10% of the Stalls and Bunks in Corporation/Municipality/Panchayat areas are to be reserved for ex-servicemen for allotment. I am to request you to initiate immediate action in this respect. This has the approval of Minister (Local Administration).

The action taken in the matter may be intimated to Government in due course.
