OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:—Reservation of posts in Public Enterprises for Ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action.

The undersigned is directed to refer to BPR's O. M. of even number dated 22-1-1980 on the subject mentioned above circulating Department of Personnel and Administrative Reform's O. M. Notification No. 39016/10/79-Estt (C) dated 15-12-1979 which makes available to the Ex-servicemen certain facilities, including reservations in posts and services on a permanent basis. A point has been raised for clarification as to whether the same percentage of reservations in public enterprise has was in force w.e.f. 1-7-1974 viz. 17½% in Group III and 27½% in Group IV should continue to be followed.

2. In this connection, attention is also invited to para 4 of BPE's O. M. No. BPE/GL-906/78/MAN/2(68)/76-BPE (GM)-I dated 30th March 1978 in which it has been stated that the Central Public Enterprises where the ceiling or 50% reservations has reached taking together reservations for SC/STs, Ex-service men and dependents of those killed in action and also promotions from Group 'D' to Group 'C' the quota for ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action would be correspondingly reduced so as to enable reservation for physically handicapped. The net percentages of reservation for ex-servicemen and dependents of those killed in action have therefore, been reduced to 14½% and 24½% Group 'C' and 'D' posts respectively in public enterprises after reserving 3% of posts both in Group "C and D" for physically handicapped vide BPE's OM dated 30-3-1978 mentioned above.

3. The Ministry of Industry etc. are requested to bring this to the notice of all public sector enterprises under their administrative control for guidance and compliance.
