RECRUITMENT INTO DSC

1. It has been brought to the notice of this Headquarters that there is large deficiency of power in DSC due to domestic commitments of an ex-servicemen and they may not seek immediate re-enrolment after their retirement. They also prefer re-employment closer to their home to attend to the family requirements.
2. To attract ex-servicemen for recruitment into DSC, posting on Zonal basis has been revised recently and Record Office Instructions issued down to platoon level. Under this revised policy, India has been divided into four Zones as mentioned under:-
 - (a) North Western Zone, J&K, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Chandigarh and Delhi.
 - (b) Central Zone : Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra (North of Pune line) and Gujarat.
 - (c) Southern Zone : Maharashtra (South of Pune line), Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Goa, Pondicherry and Orissa (South of Patna - Bhuvaneshwer Line)
 - (d) Eastern Zone : Bihar (East of Patna-Bhuvaneshwer Line), Orissa, West Bengal, Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Manipur, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura.
3. All ZROs and Regt/Corps Training Centres are requested to explain the revised policy to the candidates and encourage more number of ex-servicemen to join the DSC. All out efforts are made by DSC Records to post the ex-servicemen back to their home state after training and during the last tenure of service.
4. BROs should explain the new policy to the candidates. All ZROs are requested to inform Zila Sainik Boards located in their area of jurisdiction accordingly.
