Sir,

It has been brought to the notice by the Director, Sainik Welfare, Trivandrum that the Driving licence of some ex-servicemen drivers issued outside the Kerala State are not being renewed by the Licensing authorities of this State as their licences are subjected to further scrutiny from the offices of original issue which are normally located at far flung corners of the country where they had served. Such scrutiny takes months and years and often deny-ex-servicemen their livelihood.

The question has been examined in detail and the following instructions are issued.

When ex-servicemen produce the Driving Licences for renewal supported by copies of their discharge certificates conduct certificate etc., they need not be asked to comply with the requirements mentioned in the reference cited. It may also be borne in mind that in this letter under reference it was already directed that the genuine person should not be put to any inconvenience.
