ORDER

In the Government of India Memorandum read above, it has been
clarified that the re-employed Defence Personnel availing of the extended
insurance cover against death after retirement, for a period of 10 years
or till the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier on the person concerned
paying a lumpsum amount as prescribed therein under the Group
Insurance Scheme applicable to the members of the Armed Forces,
shall not be eligible to become members of the Central Government
employees Group Insurance Scheme 1980 as long as they continue to
avail such insurance cover. Government have decided to apply the above
provision in the case of re-employed Defence personnel in adjusting
their in the State Government Employees' Group Insurance Scheme
1984 also as long as they continue to avail the extended insurance cover
referred to above.

A new sub-rule "Giv- The re-employed former personnel availing the extended insurance cover under the Group Insurance Schemes applicable to the members of the Armed Forces as long as they continue to avail such insurance cover" is accordingly incorporated under rule 3.2 of the Group Insurance Scheme for the State Government Employees stated in the Government Order dated 9-8-1984 read above.
