As per the G.O. read as first paper above, Govt. had approved a scheme for providing house building grant to Ex-Servicemen. The benefit of the scheme was extended to the war widows and widows of Military personnel who died/die in harness as per the G.O. read as second paper above. The quantum of financial assistance given to each disabled Ex-servicemen was Rs. 15,000/- and the amount of financial assistance to war widows and jawans disabled in action was Rs.20,400/-. The above amount of Rs. 15,000/- and Rs.20,400/- given as house building grant was enhanced to Rs.26,500/-to all categories viz. disabled and boarded out Ex-servicemen was widows and widows of jawans died/die-in harness as per the G.O. read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above and the income limit for granting the house building grant was enhanced from Rs. 12,000 to Rs.25,000/ vide G.O. read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above.

Now, the Director of Sainik Welfare vide letter 5<sup>th</sup> cited has recommended that the existing house building grant of Rs.26,500/-may be enhanced to Rs.50,000/- and the income limit of Rs.25,000/- for granting the above amount to Rs.50,000/-.

Govt. have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that as recommended by the Director of Sainik Welfare the existing house building grant of Rs.26,500/- is enhanced to Rs.50,000/-the income limit of Rs.25,000/-for granting the above amount is also enhanced to Rs.50,000/-.
