**ORDER**

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above Government have approved a scheme of Awarding Scholarship to bright students among the children of Ex-Servicemen whose annual income does not exceed Rs. 30,000. The income limit was enhanced to Rs. 50,000 as per Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above. The existing rate of scholarship was fixed as per Government Order read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above.

As per Resolution No. 12 of the Minutes of the Rajya Sainik Board Meeting held on 25-11-2009, presided over by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, the committee approved a proposal to enhance the scholarship rate and income limit with effect from 1-4-2010. Based on the recommendation of Rajya Sainik Board Meeting, the Director of Sainik Welfare vide his letter read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above has furnished a proposal to enhance the income limit from Rs. 50,000 (Rupees Fifty Thousand) to Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh) and also to enhance the present rate of scholarship.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the present rate of scholarship and the income limit for the Award of scholarship are enhanced with effect from 1-4-2010 as given below:—
