ESTABLISHMENT—SOLDIERS', SAILORS' AND AIRMEN'S BOARD ORGANISATION—RECRUITMENT OF STAFF—PROCEDURE—PRESCRIBED.

ORDER

According to the G. O. read above, the District Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Boards which were Local Bodies have been declared as normal departments of the Government with effect from 1-3-1964 so as to be a single department under the control of the State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board which was already a Government Department. The Secretary, State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board is thus the Head of the Department of the Soldiers' Board Organisation in the State. Recruitment to the District Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Boards, however, is limited to Ex-servicemen only vide item 2 of the Annexure to the G. O. read above, whereas there is no such restriction in regard to the recruitment to the State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board. Now that the State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board and the District Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Boards have become different units under the same Department, it is necessary that the same qualifications, method of recruitment etc. should be made applicable for recruitment of staff to these units. The third meeting of the Indian Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board held at New Delhi under the Presidentship of the Union Defence Minister has also passed a resolution that only Ex-servicemen be appointed in future vacancies in the State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Boards. Government therefore direct, in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission, that future appointments to the State Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board will be restricted to Ex-servicemen as in the case of appointments to the District Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Boards.
