ORDER

At present the pay of a military pensioner is fixed as per rule 102, Part III, Kerala Service Rules (incorporated vide G.O. (P) 728/79/Fin dated 10-8-1979) which was framed on the basis of the Government of India Office Memorandum's issued from time to time. The Government of India have in their Office memorandum read above enhanced the limits of ignorable portion of Military pension while fixing pay of military pensioners. As per this Office Memorandum, in the case of those ex-servicemen retiring before attaining the age of 55, the pension as indicated below may be ignored when fixing their pay on re-employment.

- (i) in the case of serving Officers, the first Rs. 250/- on pension;
- (ii) in the case of personnel below commissioned officers rank, the entire pension.

1. The pension for the purpose of the above orders include pension equivalent to gratuity and other forms of retirement benefits.

2. The Government are pleased to extend the above benefits to the re-employed military pensioners of the state Government. This orders take effect from 25-1-83.

3. In G.O. (P) 25/84/Fin dated 12-1-1984 it was ordered that Central Government pensioners/pensioners governed by A. I. S. Rules who are re-employed under State Governments and State Government pensioners who are re-employed under State Government will be allowed dearness Allowance both on re-employed pay and on pension. As the orders stand at present this is not applicable to re-employed military pensioners.

4. The question of extending the benefit of G. O. (P) 25/84/ Fin dated 12-1-1984 has been under the consideration of the Government for some time past. Government after examining the question in all its aspects, are pleased to extend the benefit of G. O. (P) 25/84/Fin dated 12-1-1984 to the re-employed military pensioners also.

5. Necessary amendments to rule 102 Part III, Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
