ORDER

In the Government Order read above it was ordered among other things that the initial pay of ex-combatant Clerks/Storemen re-employed in Civil Service as L.D. Clerks/Junior Clerks/Storemen under State Government would be fixed at a higher stage in the scale above the minimum by allowing one increment for each completed year of service in the Defence Forces as combatant Clerks/Storemen. Subsequently Government in consultation with the Government of India have examined the question whether the ex-combatant Clerks/Storemen re-employed in Government Service as Typists can also be brought under the purview of the above G.O. As it is clarified by the Government of India that combatant Clerks in Defence Forces should know typing also and also taking into account that there is no separate category as Typist under the Government of India and the Typist and Clerks have the same scale of pay under that Government, it is considered that there is no intention to exclude such personnel who got appointed as Typists in Civil Departments from the benefits of fixation of pay taking into account their service in the Defence Forces. Government are therefore pleased to order that the benefits contemplated in the G. O. read will be extended also to the ex-combatant Clerks/Storemen retired/released from service in the Armed Forces and re-employed as Typists in the Civil Departments. They will, however, exercise their option as required in the G. O.

The option should be exercised within three months of the date of the order. No arrears as a result of the application of these orders will be admissible for the period prior to 7-9-1974.
