N.S.S. -- Weightage of marks to N.S.S./N.C.C. Certificate holders - I.U.C.C. recommendations and Syndicate resolution - Orders Issued.

ORDER

In the University Order read as 1st paper above sanction was accorded to the N.S.S./N.C.C. certificate holders being given weightage of 10 marks at the time of admission to higher course of study. And in the University Order 2nd cited the Academic Council considered the matter again and resolved that 3% of the total marks be given by way of relaxation and weightage to N.S.S./N.C.C. certificate holders for purposes of ranking and selection for admission to higher classes. The Academic Council considered the matter again and resolved that no weightage of marks be given for admission to professional courses like Medicine and Engineering and this was communicated vide University Order third cited.

The University of Calicut also resolved to give certain marks to N.S.S./N.C.C. certificate holders for ranking purposes. But the quantum of weightage was different. Hence the question was placed before the I.U.C.C. The I.U.C.C. considered the matter and reposed it to the Expert Committee constituted for this purpose. The committee made the following recommendations.

1, Bonus marks in respect of N.C.C. and N.S.S. candidates are to be given for admission to all courses under the universities other than professional courses, for purpose of ranking. The quantum of bonus marks to be awarded shall be as follows:-

i) In respect of N.C.C. applicants, the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of N.C.C. certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of the N.C.C. to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.

ii) For awarding bonus marks to N.S.S. participants the basis will be N.S.S. certificate signed by the Vice-Chancellor and issued by the University to volunteers who have completed 240 hours of work within a period of two years in the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.

iii) The benefit of bonus marks for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category - either N.S.S. or N.C.C.

2. Professional Courses: The Committee recommends that no bonus marks need be awarded for the professional courses for purposes of ranking.

The recommendations of the committee were placed before the Syndicate of the University of Kerala.

The Syndicate at its meeting held on 4th August 1980 considered the above recommendations of the Expert Committee constituted by the I.U.C.C. for considering the question of giving weightage of marks to N.S.S. and N.C.C. certificate holders, for ranking and selection of students for admission to various courses in the affiliated colleges and resolved that the recommendations of the Committee be approved. The matter was then placed before the Academic Council. The academic council at its meeting held on 25th October 1980 resolved as follows:-

That the following proposals be agreed to for implementation from the academic year 1981-'82.

1. Bonus marks in respect of N.C.C. and N.S.S. candidates are to be given for admission to all courses under the Universities, other than Professional Courses, for purpose of ranking. The quantum of bonus marks to be awarded shall be as follows:-

- a) Pre-Degree : 10 marks
- b) Degree Classes : 15 marks
- c) Post-graduate Courses : 5 marks

- i) In respect of N.C.C. applicants the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of N.C.C. - iii) The benefit of bonus marks for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category (either N.S.S. or N.C.C.)

The weightage of bonus marks may be added to the marks scored by the candidate either to make him eligible for admission to a course of study or for ranking purpose to those who are otherwise eligible for admission. In the case of candidates who get the eligibility by this bonus marks, their ranking mark will be the sum of scored marks and the bonus marks.

2 Professional courses : Resolved that no bonus marks need be awarded for the Professional courses for purposes of ranking.
