ORDER

AS per the existing Special Rules of Livestock Inspector Grade – II issued as per the Government Order read as second paper above, out of the 85% of vacancies earmarked for direct recruitment, 10% of vacancies are reserved for the dependents of the defences Services Personnel in the following Order of priority as ordered in the G.O. read as first paper above.

- (i) Ex-Service personnel
- (ii) Wives & Children of Ex-Service personnel
- (iii) Wives and Children of serving personnel
- (iv) Dependent brothers and sisters of Ex-Service personnel &Serving personnel.

But the dependents of defence personnel died and those killed in action/missing were not included in the said order of priority.

The Director of Sainik Welfare has suggested that the benefit given to dependents of Ex-Service Personnel and dependents of Serving personnel can be made applicable to dependents of jawans killed in action/missing and deceased Ex-Service men also. The Secretary, Kerala Public Service Commission has also considered this proposal in all respect and take up the matter with Government.

Government have examined the matter and are pleased to reassign the order of priority earmarked for the dependents of jawans etc. as follows.

- i) Ex-Service Personnel
- ii) Wives & Children of Jawans killed in action/missing

- iii) Wives & Children of Ex-Service/Deceased Ex-Service personnel
- iv) Wives & Children of serving personnel
- v) Dependent brothers & Sisters of Jawans killed in action
- vi) Dependent brothers & sisters of Ex-service and serving personnel

The G.O. read as first paper above will stand modified to the above extent.

Government are also pleased to Order that General Reserve Engineering Force (GREF) will also come within the ambit of the expression "Dependents of jawans" in the recruitment relating to the Post of Livestock Inspector in Animal Husbandry Department.
