As per the G. O. read above, the educational concessions available to the children of defence personnel, killed in action, who are studying in Degree Courses in Arts & Science Colleges, have been extended to such students studying in professional colleges also. But, the above benefits are not being allowed to the students studying for the Medical Courses due to lack of specific orders in the matter. The Principal, Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram as per the letter read above, has referred the case of one Kumari Manjusha Padma, admitted to the MBBS course during 1989 under the quota for children of defence personnel killed in action for sanctioning the concessions allowed in the Government Order read above. The Director of Medical Education has recommended the proposal.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the
concessions allowed in the G. O. read as first paper above will be extended to the children of
defence personnel killed in action, studying in Medical/Dental Colleges, College of Nursing/Pharmacy
in the Medical Colleges also.

 Sanction is also accorded for the disbursement of the concessions admissible to Kumari Manjusha Padma, MBBS student of Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram.
