As per the G.O. read as 2nd paper above, Government have enhanced the exgratia to the defence personnel who are disabled/wounded in action and who belongs to Kerala from Rs.1000 to Rs.5000 to Rs.3000 - Rs.15,000 depending on the disability or gravity of wounds. The Director of Sainik Welfare in his letter read as 3rd paper above has suggested to enhance the rates stipulated in the G.O. first cited.

2. Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to enhance the exgratia given to the defence personnel at the following rates depending on the degree of disability of the individual as can be ascertained from the discharge certificate issued by the medical authorities of Defence Services.

Nature of disability	Exgratia
1 Double amputee and totally blind	15,000
2 Double amputee	12,000
3 Totally blind	12,000
4 Single amputee and one eye blind and deaf	9,000
5 Single amputee	7,500
6 One eye blind	7,500
7 Deaf	7,500

8 Loss of toes/fingers	7,500
9 Burn/Gun shot wounds	6,000
10 Battle accident/multiple compound fracture	3,000

3. The eligibility conditions and the procedure for grant of exgratia will remain unchanged as ordered in the Government Order read as 2nd paper above.
