

RESERVATION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN IN GOVERNMENT JOBS

1. All posts in Sainik Welfare Department are reserved for Ex-servicemen.
2. Civilian posts in NCC department are reserved for ex-servicemen.
3. 10% of the total post of Live Stock Inspector Grade-II in Animal Husbandry department is reserved for ex-servicemen subject to certain conditions.
4. 10% of Driver post in Police Department is reserved for Ex-servicemen.
5. 2/3 post of Sergeant in various departments are reserved for Ex-servicemen through direct recruitment.
6. The post of Female Warden, Hospital Cleaner, Ayah (Health Department), 10% is reserved for Ex-servicemen and their families.
7. Priority has been given to Ex-servicemen in direct recruitment in the post of Forest Guard Grade-II.
8. Priority has been given to Ex-servicemen in the post of Amin in the department of Justice.
9. Priority has been given to the wife of service personnel for the appointment in Education Department up to high school level if all the bench mark is same as of the counterpart in general category.
10. A maximum of 5 years of age relaxation is given to the Ex-servicemen and 10 years to the dependants of soldier who died in war or war-like circumstances for the appointment in Government / Public Sector undertaking departments.
11. The post of security supervisors and guards in state government office complexes, public sector institutions and universities in the state has been reserved for ex-servicemen.
12. Maximum age limit for applying the post through PSC notification for ex-servicemen who have specified educational qualification for the post is 50 years subject to the certain conditions. Further a maximum of 15 marks as weightage marks has been given to short-listed ex-servicemen by counting 01 mark for each of 02 years of service in the forces and should not exceed 23 marks in all category of weightage
