INSTRUCTIONS

1. Persons eligible for the Scholarship: Ex-Servicemen including those deceased or killed in action) their wives, sons and daughters, are eligible for the scholarship. Only one person among the above will be eligible at a time during the financial year.
2. Procedure for applying:
 - a) The scholarship is no be applied for in the prescribed form to be obtained from Zila Sainik Welfare Officer concerned whom it is to be submitted after getting the relevant columns filled up by both the applicant and the Head of the Institution where the student undergoes the course of study.
 - b) The Scholarship could be applied for by the Ex-Servicemen or in his absence by the Guardian of the student and when both are not available by the student if aged above 18 years.
 - c) Every application should invariably be accompanied by an income certificate showing the annual income from all sources of the applicant and attested true copy of the Discharge Certificate/Pension order/Identity Card. (Annual income limit fixed for applying for the Scholarship is Rs.....).
3. Scholarship will be available for undergoing full time course in professional, Technical and Vocational in any Government Institution or Private Institution recognised by Government / Competent Authority.
4. Amount of Scholarship: Amount of Scholarship will be the rates fixed by the State Managing Committee from time to time and also subject to availability of fund earmarked for the year.
5. Scholarship is payable to a student only for the first year of study in a particular class. Failed students are not eligible for scholarship for the particular course.
6. The maximum age limit for granting scholarship is 25 years a on the date of commencement of the financial year.
7. Amalgamated Fund's scholarship is not allowable to recipients of other scholarship.
8. Students who have secured 50% and above marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination in the respective courses are only eligible to apply for the scholarship (For example if the application for scholarship is for a Post Graduate Course the student should have secured 50% of marks in the Degree Course. Attested copy of the mark list should be attached.
