OFFICE MEMORANDUM

*Subject:—*Grant of Special Casual Leave for the period spent by Ex-servicemen boarded out of the service and re-employed as civilians for appearing before the Medical Re-survey Boards.

The undersigned is directed to state that the question regarding the treatment of the period spent by Ex-servicemen boarded out of service and re-employed as civilians for appearing before the Medical Re-survey Board for re-assessment of their disability had been under consideration of the Government for some time past. It has now been decided that special casual leave for a maximum period of 15 days, including the transit time in both ways, may be granted to Ex-servicemen boarded out of the service and re-employed as civilians for appearing before the medical Re-survey Board for re-assessment, of their disability.
