OFFICE MEMORANDUM

*Subject:*—Rehabilitation of disabled ex-servicemen and of families of Defence Services Personnel killed whether during wartime or peace time—Grant of priority for the purposes of employment.

Reference Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms QM No. 14/21/71-Estt. (D) dated 25-12-1971.

2. The undersigned is directed to say that the question of revision of priorities for extension of welfare and resettlement of benefits to ex-servicemen has been under consideration in consultation with the Ministry of Defence & D. G. E&T. It has now been decided that for the purposes of appointment to Groups 'C' and 'D' posts under the Central Government filled through the employment exchange, the disabled ex-servicemen disabled whether during war or in peace time, but disability attributable to military service shall be accorded priority I along with retrenched employees of Government who are already included in that priority. It has also been decided to grant priority immediately after the disabled ex-servicemen i. e. priority II-A to up to 2 members each of the families of defence service personnel killed in service or severely disabled (with over 50% disability and who have become unfit for employment but disability attributable to military service) whether during war time or peace time.
