NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. No. 223/82— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the post of Sergeants in the Various Departments, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement:*—(1) These rules may be called the Special Rules for the post of Sergeants in the Various Departments of Government, 1982.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Constitution:*—The post of Sergeants in the Various Departments of the Government other than the Secretariat shall constitute separate class in the Kerala General Subordinate service.

3. *Appointment:*—Appointment to the post of Sergeant shall be made as follows:—

(i) by direct recruitment;

or

(ii) recruitment by transfer from any other class, category or service.

4. *Appointing authority:*—The appointing authority shall be the Head of the Department or any other officer authorised in this behalf by the Government or by the Head of the Department.

5. *Qualification regarding age:*—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed thirty-five years of age on the first day of January of the year in which applications for appointment are invited. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Class or ex-servicemen shall be eligible for the usual age relaxation.

Provided that persons qualified for recruitment by transfer from any other class, category or service shall be eligible for age relaxation to the extent of their service under Government to apply for appointment by Direct Recruitment.

6. *Other qualifications:*—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post of Sergeant in any Department other than Secretariat unless he possesses the qualifications specified below:—

(i) Must be a pensioned Junior Commissioned officer of the Army or equivalent in the Navy or Air Force;

or

(ii) In the absence of candidates with the qualification mentioned in item (i) above, a minimum proficiency in English and ten years military service in the Army, Navy or Air Force;

or

(iii) In the absence of qualified hands under items (i) and (ii) above, S.S.L.C. or equivalent or six months' Police or Military Training.

Note:— A working knowledge in Malayalam or Tamil or Kannada shall be an essential qualification.

7. *Reservation of appointment:*—The rules of reservation of appointment (General Rules 14-17) shall apply for appointments to the post, by direct recruitment.

8. *Probation:*—Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
