Abstract.—Welfare of ex-servicemen—Relaxation of age limit to ex-servicemen for appointment in Public Service—Proposal—Orders issued.

ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, Government have ordered, among other things that the period of service in Armed Forces put in by Ex-servicemen and the period of unemployment on discharge upto a maximum of 3 years shall be excluded for the purpose of reckoning age limits prescribed for recruitment to various posts in Government Service.

The State S.S. and A. Board in its meeting held on 24th February 1970 resolved to request Government to allow upto 5 years the period of unemployment on discharge from military service to Ex-servicemen for exemption from age limit for appointment to Government Service. The Government have examined the question in consultation with the Public Service Commission and they order that the period of unemployment upto a maximum 5 years shall be excluded in the case of Ex-servicemen for the purpose of reckoning age limits prescribed for recruitment to various posts in Government service.
